SPECIES AND CHARACTER PROFILES

TIGERS

There are five different species of tiger, which live in various places around the world. Three sub-species of tiger are now extinct. Tigers have stripy coats that provide camouflage against their forest homes. Their long tails help keep them balanced. They have razor-sharp teeth and enormous claws making them one of the most dangerous hunters in the world. Tigers do not chase their prey. They stalk it quietly, creeping close enough to pounce.

TIGRESS

Character: Over-achieving, brave, fearless Kung Fu style: The traditional tiger style is powerful, strong, firm and aggressive. Tigress strikes directly without hesitation, utilizing speed, agility and power to shatter opponents' defences. Like the traditional tiger fighter, Tigress stays close to the ground; she is agile, acrobatic, elegant, fighting honourably and never using her claws...unlike Tai Lung.

SNOW LEOPARDS

Snow leopards live in the inhospitable mountain region of central Asia and the Himalayas. Their fur helps them blend into the snow in winter and the rocks in summer. Snow leopards have long hind legs and shorter front legs, which makes them fantastic jumpers. They can jump up to 15 metres through the air, into trees or between rocks. Snow leopards are able to kill animals up to three times their own weight! They eat slowly and protect their kill from scavengers for days.

TAI LUNG

Character: Arrogant, vengeful, treacherous

Kung Fu style: The traditional leopard style relies on the enormous upper body strength - the fighter crouches, remaining low to the ground. Tai Lung uses brute strength, speed and agility, all ruled by a cunning mind. A master of all

styles, he can pinpoint and exploit weakness while facing many opponents. While plotting in jail for 20 years, Tai Lung's kung fu has evolved - his inner anger has taken over.
